FLFD Film Festival

Theme: Contemporary Life

Each school is eligible to submit one film per language. Below are the mandatory guidelines for the film submission.

- Must be in the target language
- Must adhere to the theme
- Must be submitted by a modern language teacher.
- Must include student names and film title in the credits/introduction
- Must be uploaded to google drive as an MP4
- Must be submitted as a google drive link via the submission form FLFD Film Festival Submission.
- Must be saved with the following naming convention: FLFD_(language)film_(teachername) Example: FLFD_spanishfilm_johnsmith
- Must be less than 10 minutes (including introduction and closing credits)
- Must include 2-6 participants who have speaking parts

Due Date: All submissions must be received by 11:59 pm on April 14. to be considered for scoring. Once received, videos will be sent to MSSU for judging.

Once videos are received they will be sent to the MSSU ModernLanguage Department for judging. In addition to the mandatory guidelines, films will be judged with the following criteria in mind.

- Shared dialogue
- Interpretation/Representation topic
- Cultural Competency
- Pronunciation & Enunciation
- Amount of target language used
- Difficulty/authenticity of the target language used
- Use of Grammar/Vocabulary
- Acting
- Overall film quality
- Originality/Creativity
- Props/costumes (if necessary)
- Music (if necessary)

Additional Notes:

- *Failure to follow guidelines will result in a disqualified video submission.
- *All recordings must have an adequate volume level and clarity. If the audio is not audible, the submission will not be counted.
- *Winners will be announced on the day of the competition.
- *The "judges' choice" winner may be shown during awards.
